## Vestry Minutes January 21, 2024

The meeting open on zoom at 1:00 p.m. with prayer by Mth Darlene. Attendance: Mth Darlene Kuhn, Tim French, Marilee Roth, Judy Joseph, Joanne Sims, Mary White, Alyce Carter, and Barbara Ryan.

In the treasurer's absence Tim discussed the finances. We had income of over \$32,000, in December which exceeded the budgeted amount. The deficit for 2023 was approximately \$6000. instead of the budged amount. We have a balanced budget for 2024 with Mth Darlene working parttime and should be in sound financial shape going forward. Tim suggested Mth Darlene explain reasons for changing to parttime at the annual meeting, allows for balanced budget and more time for her to take care of her health.

The musicians will be recognized March 13, outreach coordinator Linda Anderson April 17, lay readers another Sunday in March. Discussed being careful to not ignore anyone.

Church closing policy was discussed. Mth Darlene will make decision in coordination with the wardens, publish to all via the internet, post to Facebook, and call those without internet access. Babara suggested she also talk to Judy about the road conditions since Judy lives at the southern end of our attendance area.
