A Call to Artists

All ages are invited to submit applications to display and share original artwork in the Art Show. Each artist is allowed to bring no more than 2 pieces of art for the show. We invite those who paint, draw, sculpt, carve, weld, sew, quilt, collage, sing, dance, author stories or poems, and play music.

Participating artists accept all responsibility for damages and/or loss should it occur. Artists are permitted to sell their art; however, it must remain displayed until the end of the show. Photos of the art will be used in a small booklet that will be handed out during the show along with your Artist Statement and Artist Bio.

Display Criteria: The artist will prepare the artwork to be ready for installation. Preparation for display includes proper framing, if necessary, with wire on the backs of frame, glass, and/or canvas of the artwork. 3D artwork needs to be prepared for hanging or for a flat surface display. The Curatorial Board will make final decisions on acceptance and will not accept any objectionable or politically partisan themed works.

Selling Art: Artists can sell their art, but the work must remain on display until the end of the show. The Episcopal Church of the Mediator does not take any commissions on any sales. All sales or sales tax are between the artist and the purchaser. If artists sell their work and are not able to be present during the showing times, all arrangements for the sale and transfer of the artwork to the purchaser is the responsibility of the artist.
